CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **KARL I. UNGER**

of Route 2, Box 80, Beaverton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Hall Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of Supply for lily pond & irrigation of domestic garden not exceeding 1 acre in area under Permit No. 11947 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 14, 1935;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.1 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, Township 1 South, Range 1 West, W. M., in William Lockerman D. L. C. 45.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.5 acre in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 10
 0.5 acre & Lily Pond in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 15
 Township 1 South, Range 1 West, W. M.,
 being within William Lockerman D. L. C. 45.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
