has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from February 28, 1930;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.2 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotat on measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW SW, Section 14, Township 1 South, Renge 48 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrilation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be imited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation sy tem as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.5 acres in the NW1SW4
1.5 acres in the SW4NW4
Section 14
1.5 acres in the SF4NE4
8.4 acres in the NE4NE4
Section 15
1.6 acres in the SF4SE4
Section 10
Township 1 South, Range 48 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
