CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That U. S. FOREST SERVICE--WHITMAN NATIONAL FOREST

of Baker, State of Oregon, has made proof

to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of

Meadow Brook, tributary of North Fork John Day River, the water to be appropriated under Application No. 16398, Permit No. 12198,

for the purposes of Domestic and Irrigation

under Reservoir Permit No. R-690 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 9, 1936;

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 0.06 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located in Section 1 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4), Tp. 7 S., R. 31 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to correct and supersede that certain certificate of water right issued April 2, 1940 to the United States Forest Service, Whitman National Forest and recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 11, Page 12504, so as to correctly describe and record the location of the reservoir as to the county in which it is situated.
