## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** ROLLIN E. BAKER

of Enterprise, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Spring Creek, a tributary of Wallowa River for the purpose of Irrigation & Stock, being 0.17 c.f.s. for irrig., & 0.01 c.f.s. for stock under Permit No. 13932 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 19, 1939;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.18 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 11, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of ~~of one cubic foot per second per acre~~, not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any 30 day period from May 1 to July 31 and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for the remainder of the irrigation season,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10 acres and Stock in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 11  
Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
