CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. L. JENNINGS

of 2138 N. E. Halsey St., Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Haskins Creek a tributary of Yamhill River for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 10816 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 31, 1933;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.72 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at a point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW¹/₄NE¹/₄, Section 8, Township 3 South, Range 5 West, W. M., being within Peleg Hibbard D. L. C. 47.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.2 acre in the SW¹/₄SW¹/₄
19.7 acres in the SE¹/₄SW¹/₄
8.0 acres in the SW¹/₄SE¹/₄
Section 4
13.2 acres in the NE¹/₄NW¹/₄
15.1 acres in the NW¹/₄NW¹/₄
0.8 acre in the NW¹/₄NE¹/₄
Section 9
Township 3 South, Range 5 West, W. M.,
being within Peleg Hibbard D. L. C. 47.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
