CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROBERT LISTER

of Paulina, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Wolf Creek, tributary of Beaver Creek and Beaver Creek a tributary of Crooked River for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 12350 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 4, 1936;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, Township 15 South, Range 24 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

25.0 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 4.8 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
 3.2 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 4
 Township 16 South, Range 24 East, W. M.
