CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That U. S. FOREST SERVICE--MT. HOOD NAT'L FOREST

of Terminal Sales Bldg., Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Three Springs and Salmon River a tributary of Sandy River for the purpose of Domestic and Industrial (steam boiler) under Permit No. 17461 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 2, 1936 for Salmon River and November 27, 1936 for springs;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.2 cubic foot per second, being 0.03 c.f.s. from Spring # 1 for domestic use at Timberline Lodge; 0.02 c.f.s. for industrial use from Spring # 2; 0.05 c.f.s. from Spring # 3 for industrial use and 0.1 c.f.s. for domestic and industrial use from Salmon River

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, Township 3 South, Range 9 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 6
Township 3 South, Range 9 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
