## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

for the purpose of irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order

Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 3, at page 252; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1893;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 1.73 sec. ft. from March 1 to July 1 and 0.365 sec. ft. from July 1 to October 1 of each year; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 173 acre-feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

10 acres in SE4 SE4

40 acres in NE4 NE4
19 acres in NW4 NE4
