CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MABEL E. WITHEYCOMBE

of Union, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of North Powder River, a tributary of Powder River, for the purpose of irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 3, at page 252; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1906;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 0.75 sec. ft. from March 1 to July 1 and 0.375 sec. ft. from July 1 to October 1 of each year; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 75 acre-feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

30 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 13, Township 7 South, Range 38 East, W. M.

NOTE: This certificate is issued to supersede certificate of water right issued to Clayton Coleman and recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 2, Page 1454, and to confirm a change in point of diversion and place of use of water approved by orders of the State Engineer, dated August 23, 1938, and January 24, 1940, pursuant to Section 116-606, O. C. L. A.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
