CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. M. STEPHENS AND MARY E. STEPHENS

of Burnt Ranch, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
 the waters of Bridge Creek
 for the purpose of irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Wheeler County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12 serially at page 3881 ET seq., that the priority
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1863.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes; and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic
 foot per second per acre of land irrigated before June 15, and one-eightieth of one
 cubic foot per second per acre after June 15, during the irrigation season from March 1
 to October 1 of each year, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
 (to) A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,
 if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

19	acres in SE ₁ SE ₄ Section 33;
15	acres in SW ₁ SW ₄
