CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HANNAH J. HARTER

of Tumalo, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Deschutes River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Deschutes County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 9, at page 362; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from April 15, 1905;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4 acre-feet per acre,
measured at the point of diversion from the stream, which may be diverted at a
rate not to exceed 1/40th of one cubic foot per second per acre from May 23 to
August 20 and 1/80th of one cubic foot per second per acre from April 1 to May 23
and August 20 to November 1.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

1.75 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$,
being Lots 6, 7, 8, 9,
10, 11 and 12, in
Block 1,
Townsite of Laidlaw
(now Tumalo)
Section 31,
T. 16 S., R. 12 E. W. M.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use
herein described.
