CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That B. F. MADSEN

of Camp Sherman, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
 the waters of North Fork Lake Creek
 for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Deschutes County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 9, at page 362; that the priority
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from June 1, 1908;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3 acre-feet per acre,
 measured at the point of diversion from the stream, which may be diverted at a
 rate not to exceed 1/60th of one cubic foot per second per acre during the irri-
 gation season from May 1 to September 15.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,
 if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

5.5 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 15.3 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 5.1 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 10,
 T. 13 S., R. 9 E. W. M.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is limited to the lands or place of use
 herein described.
