and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 9 , at page 362; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1901;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed 2 acre-feet per acre, measured at the point of diversion from the stream, which may be diverted at a rate not to exceed 1/60th of one cubic foot per second per acre during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

> 8 acres in SW4 NW4 30 acres in NW SW 4 acres in SWA SWA 10 acres in SE's SW 10 acres in SW4 SE 10 acres in SET SET Section 2' 12 acres in SW NE 20 acres in SE NE 21 acres in NET SET Section 28, T. 12 S., R. 14 E. W. M.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
