CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That L. D. WIEST

of Bend, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Deschutes River for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Deschutes County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 9, at page 362; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from October 31, 1900;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one cubic foot per second measured at the point of intake from Pilot Butte Canal or flume.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

- 15 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 28, 15 acres in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 40 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 33, T. 17 S., R. 12 E. W. M.

1/2 ac trsf. - Sp'Or. Vol. 7, p. 220

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
