CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CITY OF COQUILLE

of Coquille, State of Oregon, has made proof

to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Rink and Walker Creeks in Rink Creek Reservoir Enlargement, (tributary of Coquille River)

for the purposes of Domestic Use (the right herein granted being limited to enlargement of a reservoir for the storage of water to be appropriated for domestic supply in addition to the storage of water under Permit No. R-613, this additional water being appropriated under Application No. 17658, Permit No. 13352)

under Reservoir Permit No. R-721 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 12, 1938;

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 121 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located in Section 4 (nw 1/4 for), Tp. 28 S., R. 12 W., W.M.
