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State of , has made proof Pendleton Oregon to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Wild Horse Creek Umatilla River a tributary of for the purpose of Irrigation of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 10823 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 18, 1933;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.34 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE1, Section 1, Township 2 North, Range 32 East, K. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per scre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall not exceed 3 acre feet per acre per season,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
