CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **WM. F. MORTON** and **LINLEY M. CRICHTON**

of 3424 N. E. 39th Ave., Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Spring a tributary of Blue Lake for the purpose of Irrigation, Operation of Hydraulic Ram & Domestic & Stock Use, being 0.01 c.f.s. for Irrigation, 0.07 c.f.s. for operation of ram & 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic & Stock under Permit No. 11987 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 9, 1935;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second, and this right shall be limited to a total diversion for all purposes at any time, except for power, of 0.02 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, Township 1 North, Range 3 East, W. M., being within Page Stanley D. L. C. 56.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.3 acre, Stock, Domestic & Ram in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33 0.8 acre in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, all Tp. 1 N., R. 3 E., W. M., in Page Stanley D. L. C. 56.

The applicants claim a vested right by virtue of use prior to 1909, and this is filed merely as a precautionary measure and shall not be construed as in any way relinquishing any vested rights the applicants may have, and shall be considered as supplemental to said vested rights.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years' notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights for the development of POWER as specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 116-426 O. C. L. A.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
