or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NET NWT, Section 31, Township 8 North, Range 9 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
