CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **ANTONE H. EVERS**

of Route 1, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Drainage Channel No. 7 and West Fork of Dairy Creek a tributary of _____ for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 13397 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 5, 1939;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.33 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, Tp. 1 N., R. 4 W., W. M., in Ellison C. Johnson D. L. C. 54, and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, Tp. 1 N., R. 4 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and this appropriation shall also be limited to the use of water from Drainage Channel No. 7 whenever such water is available, and water shall be appropriated from West Fork of Dairy Creek only at such times as there is less than 0.33 second-foot of water available in Drainage Channel No. 7, and in an amount not to exceed the quantity required to make up such deficiency; in no case shall the total quantity from both sources exceed 0.33 second-foot at any time, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.3 acre in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
11.2 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
1.0 acre in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
9.4 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

1.2 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

Ellison C. Johnson D. L. C. 54
0.6 acre in Lot 4 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
