CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CITY OF FOREST GROVE

of Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Branch of Clear Creek, tributary of Gales Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of Municipal of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 13944 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 27, 1939;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, Township 1 North, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- All of Section 31, Tp. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.
- All of Section 6, Tp. 1 S., R. 3 W., W. M.
- All of Section 36, Tp. 1 N., R. 4 W., W. M.
- NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Tp. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

This right is granted to the exclusion of all subsequent appropriations by authority of Section 47-503, Oregon Code, 1930.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
