CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HENRY R. KAISER

of Maupin , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Two Unnamed Springs a tributary of for the purpose of Domestic Use including the irrigation of domestic garden of 1/8 acre under Permit No. 10851 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 17, 1933;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 775 gallons per day,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and Lot 9 of Section 1, Township 6 South, Range 13 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic Use including irrigation of domestic garden of 1/8 acre in Lot 9, Section 1 Tp. 6 S., R. 13 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
