CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That S. D. BAKER, EMMETT ADDY, AND JOHN SLATE

of Kerby, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of

the waters of Fiddler's Gulch, Day's Gulch, and Mike's Gulch, tributaries of Illinois River, for the purpose of mining

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 13, at page 70; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from June 6, 1877;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 20.0 cubic feet per second from November 1 to August 31 of the following year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
