CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. L. BEAR

of Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Fiddler's Gulch for the purpose of mining

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 13, at page 70; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from August, 1896;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 20.0 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

All lands lying and being between Day's Gulch and Fiddler's Gulch, consisting of 280 acres and being within:

Sections 35 and 36,
T. 38 S., R. 9 W., W. M.
and Sections 1 and 2,
T. 39 S., R. 9 W., W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
