## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** TWOHY BROS. COMPANY  
 623 Underwood Building  
 of San Francisco, State of California, has a right to the use of  
 the waters of Big Spring Rice Creek and Straw Creek, tributaries of Illinois River,  
 for the purpose of irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
 Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 13, at page 70; that the priority  
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one cubic foot per  
 second for each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season from  
 April 1 to November 1 of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,  
 if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

20 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 5 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 10 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 5 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 Section 33,  
 T. 38 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

12 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 Section 4;  
 30 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
 10 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
 20 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
 20 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
 Section 5,  
 T. 39 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

NOTE: The use of water for irrigation purposes from Big Spring Rice Creek,  
 Straw Creek, and Illinois River is restricted to the quantity of water herein  
 fixed.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
 contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use  
 herein described.
