of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said watersunder Permit No. 12893 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 8, 1937

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.38 cubic feet per second, being 0.52 c.f.s. from unnamed slough and 0.86 c.f.s. from Lambert Slough,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lambert Slough: Lot 1 (NW2 NW2), Lot 2 (SE NW2) and Lot 3 (NE SW1); Unnamed Slough: Lot 11 (SE NE), both in Section 15, Township 5 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated. during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

From Lambert Slough: 20.0 acres in the SW NE 9.1 acres in the NET NW4 13.3 acres in the SE NW 3.6 acres in the NW: SE Section 15, T. 5 S., R. 3 W., W. M. being within D. L. C. 55. 7.0 acres in Lot 3 (NE SWA) 20.0 acres in Lot 9 (NR SFA) Section 15. T. 5 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

From Unnamed Slough: 7.1 acres in the SE2 NE 1.4 acres in the NE SET Section 15, T. 5 S., R. 3 W., W. M. being within D. L. C. 55. 17.3 acres in Lot 11 (SE NE 10.7 acres in Lot 10 (NE SEI) Section 15, T. 5 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
