	ut page 236 , on the 8th day of February, 1917 ; that the priority of
	the right hereby confirmed dutes from August 5, 1912 ; that the amount of
	water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not
ereund	exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State of case of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby
	confirmed is appartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 9 acres in Lot One [12] and 9 acres in Lot Two
	(12 12 12 13) of Section Five (5), Township Sixteen (16) South, Range Eleven (11) East Willemette Meridian, in Deschutes County, Oregon.
	The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
