## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That JAMES BRISTOW and JOHN and MARK NEATHAMER

of Rogue River, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Slate Creek, tributary of Grave Creek a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of Domestic and Mining, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 4.99 c.f.s. for mining under Permit No. 12930 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 15, 1938

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 5.0 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 20, Township 33 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and Mining in the  
NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 29,  
Township 33 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
