## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify; That

of our said **Burns** land, State of **Oregon**  
 the waters of **Silver Creek**

for the purpose of **irrigation and stock**

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
 the said **Harney** in **Brook County**, and the said decree entered of record at **Salem**, in the Order  
 Record of the **STATE ENGINEER**, in Volume **11** page **12** **1887** at page **298** **1887**; that the priority  
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from **1887**.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  $\frac{1}{60}$ th of one cubic foot  
 per second per acre irrigated from March 1 to April 30, and  $\frac{1}{80}$ th of one cubic foot  
 per second from May 1 to August 1; provided, that the total quantity diverted during  
 the months of March, April, May, and June shall not exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre.  
 (to) A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,  
 if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

40 acres in NW<sub>1</sub> SW<sub>1</sub>  
 40 acres in SW<sub>1</sub> SW<sub>1</sub>

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
 contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use  
 herein described.
