CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That D. J. WRIGHT

of Route 1, Box 27, Rogue River, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 1043 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 3, 1911;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 21, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

16 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
9 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 21,
T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

NOTE: This certificate is issued to supersede certificate of water right issued to Charles A. Thompson and recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 2, Page 1305, so as to confirm a change in point of diversion and place of use of water approved by an order of the State Engineer dated August 26, 1940, pursuant to Section 116-606, O. C. L. A.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use here-in described.
