CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ALFRED H. RISHER

of Route 1, Beaver Creek , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **An Unnamed Spring** a tributary of Milk Creek for the purpose of Ram & Domestic, including the irrigation of a garden not exceeding $\frac{1}{2}$ acre in area, under Permit No. 14632 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 1, 1940

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 7.0 gallons per minute, being 6.0 g.p.m. for operation of ram and 1.0 g.p.m. for domestic,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 4 South, Range 3 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 0.5 acre in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 28,
Operation of ram in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 29,
T. 4 S., R. 3 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
