CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ... M. end HUGH CALLAHAR

of Gaston , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River a tributary of Billamette River for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 12113 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 18, 1936

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE2 SE2, Section 32, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 0.25 c.f.s.,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.6 acre in the NE2 SE2 0.3 acre in the SE3 SE3, Section 32, 2.7 acres in the NE2 SW1 15.0 acres in the NW2 SW1 14.4 acres in the SW2 SW1, Section 33, T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. N.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
