of Burns ,State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of thee STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Bridge Creek a tributary of Donner and Blitzen River for the purpose of Irrigation, domestic, and stock use.

under Permit No. 1154 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 30, 1930

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to are amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.35 cubic foot per second, being 0.05 c.f.s. for domestic and stock and 0.3 c.f.s. for irrigation,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is elecated in the SN4 SE2, Section 20, Township 31 South, Range 322 East, W. M.

The amount of wester used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the sare lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Demostic and Stock in the NEL SEL and SEL SEL Demostic, Stock and 22,5 acres in the NEL SEL Desmostic, Stock and 0.6 acre in the NW SEL, Section 5, T. 31 S., R. 322 E., W. M.

The right to the raise of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
