of. , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the Mill Creek waters of Waggie Creek , a tributary of , for the purpose of the irrigation of 40 acres of land under Enlargement Permit No. 157 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume , on the 11th day of April, 1917 at page ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 15, 1912 ; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use exceed hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 40 acres in the North vest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township Eight (8) South, Range Thirty-nine (39) East of

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
