**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** JESSIE L. LOONEY & W. H. LOONEY ESTATE

of Route 5, Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Greasy Creek and Mary's River a tributary of Mary's River and Willamette River, respectively, for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 13207 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 11, 1938

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.68 cubic foot per second, being 0.22 c.f.s. from Greasy Creek and 0.46 c.f.s. from Mary's River,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Greasy Creek: SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; Mary's River: NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 11, Township 12 South, Range 6 West, W. M., being within William Matzgers D. L. C. 50.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to  $\frac{1}{34}$ th of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.8 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
6.7 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
1.1 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
8.4 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
23.0 Section 11,  
T. 12 S., R. 6 W., W. M.,  
being within William Matzgers D. L. C. 50.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
