Route 2, Silverton Oregon State of , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Abiqua Creek a tributary of Irrigation Pudding River .. for the purpose of 13395 under Permit No. of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby January 4, 1939 confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL NWL, Section 21, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.2 acres in the NW NET 15.6 acres in the NET NW, Section 21, T. 6 S., R. I W., W. M., being within John Tucker D. L. C. 59;

1.0 sire in the SW NED
3.2 acres in the SE NW,
Section 21,
T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. H.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
