## **CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

This Is to Certify, That R. E. HERMAN

of Route 1, Cornelius , State of Origon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Dairy Creek a tributary of Tualatin River

for the purpose of

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Irrigation under Permit No. 13642 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 1, 1939

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW1 SF1, Section 21, Township 1 North, Range 3 West, W. M., being within Michael Wren D. L. C. 54.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be fur ther limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation senson of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 0.2 acre in the NN, SE2 2.3 acres in the SWY SE2, Section 21, T. IF N., R. 3 W., W. M., being within Michael Wren D. L. C. 54.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
