## This is to Certify, That SAM and W. A. CARNES

of North Powder State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of North Powder River, a tributary of Powder River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 119 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the The HATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 2, at page 252 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1866;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 2.97 sec. ft. from March 1st to July 1st, and 1.49 sec. ft. from July 1st to Octoner 1st of each year; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 297 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 40 acres in SW4SW4, Section Thirty-two (32) Township Six (6) South, Range Thirty-nine (39) and 10 acres in NW4NE4; 39 acres in NE2NW4; 30 acres in NW4NW4, Section Five (5), Township Seven (7) South, Range Thirtynine (39): all East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
