CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Rogers Canning Company

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla

for the purpose of cooling its products in sealed cans after being cooked.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1872

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 31 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Section 12,
T. 5 N., R. 35 E., W. N.

NOTE: This certificate is issued to supersede that certain water right certificate issued to John L. and W. E. Miller (Northwestern Roller Mills) April 5, 1940, and recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 11, page 12,914, and to confirm a change in character of use, place of use and point of diversion of water approved by an order of the State Engineer dated November 22, 1941, pursuant to the provisions of Section 116-606, O. C. L. A.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
