## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Amos and Harriet E. Avery

of Portland, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Five springs and flood waters of Chenoweth Creek  
for the purpose of Irrigation, Domestic and Stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 10, at page 219; that the priority  
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1895

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3 acre-feet per acre,  
measured at the point of diversion from the stream, which may be diverted at a  
rate not to exceed 1/60th of one cubic foot per second per acre during the  
irrigation season from March 1 to October 1 of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,  
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

2 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
6 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
Section 25,  
T. 2 N., R. 12 E., W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use  
herein described.
