CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Fred Scott and Josephine Scott, successors to J. E. McDonnell of Jordan Valley, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Owyhee River

for the purpose of Irrigation of 50.4 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for MALHEUR County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 9, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from November 25, 1908;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled; for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1 acre foot per acre during any calendar month prior to June 1st and $\frac{3}{4}$ acre foot per acre during any calendar month after June 1st, of each year; and a total not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre during the irrigation season from April 1st to October 15th.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right; and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

10.2 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 24,
T. 31 S., R. 41 E., W. M.

8.4 acres in Lot 4 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$),
Section 19,
21.8 acres in Lot 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$),
10.0 acres in Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$),
Section 30,
T. 31 S., R. 42 E., W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
