Baker State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of North Powder River, a tributary of Powder River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 214 acres of land and domestic use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the International of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 252 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1865 for the irrigation of 53 acres; 1873 for 140 acres and 1886 for 21 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesuid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 5.36 sec. ft. from March 1st to July 1st, and 2.68 sec. ft. from July 1st to October 1st of each year; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 535 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water 30 acres in SW4 of NE4; 30 acres in SE4 is put to beneficial use, is as follows: of NW4; 37 acres in NE4 of SW4; 40 acres in SE4 of SW4; 40 acres in SW4 of SE4; 37 acres in NW4 of SE4; Section Thirty-five (35), Township Six (6) South, Range Thirty-eight (38) East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker and Union Counties, Oregon.
