CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Cer	tify, That	J.	L.	DODSON
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of Baker State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of North Powder River, a tributary of Powder River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 130 acres of land and domestic use;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Example of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 252; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1884 for the irrigation of 100 acres; and from 1966 for the irrigation of 30 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 3.25 sec. ft. from Earch 1st to July 1st and 1.65 sec. ft. from July 1st to October 1st of each year; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation s eason not to exceed 325 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 29 acres in NE3 of NE3; Section Thirty-four (34) Township Six (6) South, Range Thirty-eight (38) East of Willamette Meridian, in Union County, Oregon.

23 acres in NW2 of NE2; 40 acres in SW2 of NE2; 38 acres in SE2 of NE2; Section Thirty-four (34), Township Six South, Range Thirty-eight (38) East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
