CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That D. H. McCARGAR

, State of Oregon of Grants Pass to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Mulvaney Gulch and Democrat Gulch, being 1.10 cubic foot per second from Mulvaney Gulch and 0.20 cubic foot per second from Democrat Gulch a tributary of thouse Creek tributary of East Fork Illinois River for the purpose of being 1.10 cupic local democrat Gulch of East Fork Illinois River Irrigation of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No.11069 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 21, 1933

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.30 cubic feet per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. 40 South, Range 7 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1, to November 1,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10 acres in the NW4 NW4, 28 acres in the SWA NWA. Section 5, 2 acres in the NET NET, Section 6, T. 40 S., R. 7 W., W. M. 8 acres in the SW4 NE4, 2 acres in the NE NW . 5 acres in the SE4 NWA, 10 acres in the NV SET, Section 1, T. 40 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
