CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ERNEST THEODOR UNRATH

of Roseburg , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Unpoug River

a tributary of Ocean
for the purpose of
Irrigation and Domestic, being 0.05 second foot for irrigation and 0.01 second foot for
domestic
under Permit No. 12086
of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from March 3, 1936

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SH2 NE2 as projected on D.L.C. 45, Section 23, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, H. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic use in Lot 11 (SW1NE1 & SE1NE2), 4.0 acres in Lot 11 (SW1NE1 & SE2NE2), Section 23,

T. 26 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a 3/4 inch x 30 inch Galv. Iron pipe in the County road and from which the one fourth (1) Section corner between Sections 23 and 24 in Township Twenty six (26) South of Range Six (6) West of the Willamette Meridian in Douglas County, Oregon, bears South 35 degrees and 53' East 1087.5 feet; thence South 74 degrees 13' West 717.0 feet to a point on the Bank of the North Umpqua River marked by a 3/4 inch x 30 inch Galv. Iron pipe; thence North 15 degrees 59' West 130.3 feet to a point on the Bank of the North Umpqua River; thence North 10 degrees C5' West 152.8 feet to a point on the Bank of the North Umpqua River; thence North 13 degrees 43' Nest 211.3 feet along the Bank of the North Umpqua River to a point marked by a 3/4 inch x 30 inch Galv. Iron Pipe from which a 24 Ash scribed C.S.B.T. bears South 39 degrees East 9.0 feet; thence North 49 degrees 43' East 295.1 feet to a 3/4 inch x 30 inch Galv. Iron Pipe in the center of the County Road, and from which a 48" Black Oak, scribed C.S.B.T. beers North 123.9 feet; thence South 42 degrees 35' East 216.1 feet in the center of the County Road; thence South 53 degrees 26' East 252.5 feet in the center of County Road; thence South 53 degrees 49. East 282.3 feet in the Center of the County Road, to the place of beginning. containing 6.31 acres, more or less, and having 0.22 acres in the County Road, all lying and being situated in Douglas County, State of Oregon.

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The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
