## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. B. DAUGHERTY AND J. HARRY MORAN

of Salem, State of Oregon <sup>97309</sup>, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Naroma Creek a tributary of Little North Fork Santiam River for the purpose of Domestic under Permit No. 12231 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 23, 1936

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 15, Township 9 South, Range 2 East, T. 9 S., R. 2 E., N. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ,

T. 9 S., R. 2 E., N. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point on the south line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 10 in Township 9 South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon, which point is 1050 feet east of the quarter corner on the south line of said section, thence East 70 feet more or less to the center line of Naroma creek; thence northerly along the center line of said creek to a point which is 80 feet more or less southerly along said center line of said creek from the center line of the Little North Fork of the Santiam river, and which point is on a line running due north of the place of beginning; thence South 175 feet more or less to the place of beginning.

Beginning at the S. E. corner of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 10 in T. 9 S. R. 2 East of Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon; thence West along the south line of Section 10, 200 feet, more or less to a small Creek; thence northerly following the middle of said creek to the middle of the Little North Fork of the Santiam River; thence easterly following the middle of said River, 200 feet, more or less, to the east line of said  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section, thence south to the place of beginning.

Beginning at the S. E. corner of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 10 in Township 9 South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon, thence East along the South line of said section 10 a distance of 200 feet, more or less to a small creek; thence Northerly following the center line of said creek to the middle of the Little North Fork of the Santiam River; thence Easterly following the center line of said river, 200 feet, more or less, to the East line of said quarter section; thence

Beginning at a point, at an iron pipe on the South line of Section 10 in Township 9 South 33rd East of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County, State of Oregon, which point is 950 feet East of the quarter section corner on the south line of said section; thence West along the South line of said Section 100 Feet; thence North to the center line of the Little North Fork of the Santiam River; thence Easterly along the center line of said stream, to a point which is due North of the place of beginning; thence South to the place of beginning, being situated in the S.W. 1/4 of the S. 11, of said section 10.
