CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DOGIA E. FULTON

of Route 1, Box C37, North Bend, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Creek a tributary of Coos Bay for the purpose of Domestic including the irrigation of a domestic garden not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre in area, under Permit No. 13540 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 28, 1939

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, Township 25 South, Range 13 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 2,
T. 25 S., R. 13 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Lots 10-11-12-13, Block 25 in Glasgow Townsite.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
