**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** MIKE ENGELHARDT

of Route 1, Gervais, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed stream, a tributary of Pudding River, for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 13639 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 29, 1939

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected on Felix Coonse D.L.C. No. 56, Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.5 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected on Felix Coonse D.L.C. No. 56  
Section 31,  
T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North line of the Donation Land Claim of Felix Coonse and wife in T. 5 and 6 S. R. 1 West of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County and State of Oregon, which point is North 88°-45' West 56.36 chains from the North-east corner of said Claim, and is marked by an iron bar set for the North-west corner of a 22.97 Acre tract of land formerly owned by John Miller; Thence 0°-30' west along the West line of the Miller tract 23.86 chains to the South-west corner thereof; Thence North 88°-45' West 4.195 chains; Thence North 0°-30' East 23.86 chains to the North line of the Coonse Claim; Thence South 88°-45' East 4.194 chains to the place of beginning, containing Ten (10) acres of land, more or less.

Beginning at a point on the North boundary line of the Donation Land Claim of Felix Coonse and wife in Township Five and Six South Range One (1) West of the Willamette Meridian, in Marion County State of Oregon; Said beginning point being 60.555 chains North 88 degrees 45 Minutes West from the Northeast corner of said Donation Land Claim, and also North 88 degrees 45 minutes West 4.195 chains from the Northwest corner of a 22.97 acre tract of land formerly owned by John Miller, running thence South 0 degrees 30 minutes West parallel with the West line of the Miller tract 23.86 chains; thence North 88 degrees 45 minutes West 4.195 chains; thence North 0 degrees 30 minutes East 23.86 chains to the North line of the Coonse Claim; thence South 88 degrees 45 minutes East 4.195 chains to the place of beginning and containing Ten (10) acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
