CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EUGENE PLYWOOD COMPANY

of Eugene, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette River, a tributary of Manufacturing and maintaining pond in proper condition for the purpose of under Permit No. 14379 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 5, 1940

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.8 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected on D.L.C. 39, Section 25, Township 17 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

"A strip of land 4 feet in width, the center line of which follows the following course, to-wit: beginning at a point S 84 degrees 40' E 78 feet from the intersection of the west line of the east half of the Prior F. Blair D.L.C. No. 39 in T 17, S. R. 4 W. of the W. M. in Lane County, Oregon, being 18 feet S 84 degrees 40' E from the southwest corner of a tract of land conveyed by the Eugene Terminal Company to Cyril Sirotek et ux by a deed recorded December 8, 1926, in Book 152 at page 273 of the Deed Records of said County; thence N 34 degrees 40' E. 194.5 feet, more or less, to the north line of said tract of land."

"Beginning at a point 649.5 feet west and 745.8 feet south of the northeast corner of the Prior F. Blair Donation Land Claim No. 39 in Township 17 South Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian in Lane County, Oregon, which point is approximately 203.7 feet east of the southwest corner of a four acre tract conveyed by deed by A. Lombard and Lizzie Lombard, his wife, to Charles H. Howard and Malinda Howard, his wife, filed for record April 11, 1925, and recorded in Book 145, Page 147, Lane County Oregon Deed Records, and running north 85 degrees 13' E. 25 feet to a point 4 feet north of the south line of said property; thence 89 degrees 49' E. 4 feet distant from and parallel to the south line of said property 300.7 feet more or less to the west line of Polk Street or to the East line of said property."

"Beginning at a point 4 feet south of a point 666.1 feet east of a point 25.10 chains west and 11.30 chains south of the northeast corner of the Prior F. Blair Donation Land Claim No. 39 in Township 17 South Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian, Lane County, Oregon, which point is 4 feet south of the northwest corner of a tract of land conveyed by deed by Allen Andrews and Delma Andrews, his wife, to Lillie L. Rice and filed for record April 28, 1931, and recorded in Book 171, Page 113, Lane County, Oregon, Record of Deeds, and running thence east parallel to and 4 feet south of the north line of said property 339 feet; thence north 85 degrees 13' E. 25 feet, more or less, to the north line of said property."

"Beginning at a point on the easterly line of the Secondary Pacific Ry. (formerly County road No. 200) South 7 degrees 40' E. 183.5 feet from a point 1626.6 feet west and 745.8 feet south of the northeast corner of the Prior F. Blair Donation Land Claim No. 39 in Township 17 South Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian, Lane County, Oregon, being south 7 degrees 40' E. 183.5 feet from a point 30 feet east of the southwest corner of a tract deeded by Elizabeth C. Thomason and W. J. Thomason, her husband, to C. C. Thomason and Ethel Thomason, his wife, and filed for record December 15, 1927, in Book 157, Page 254, Deed Records for Lane County, Oregon, and running thence east parallel to and 9 feet distant from the north line of a roadway 50 feet wide known as Thomason Street running through said property 620.0 feet to a point 4 feet west of the east line of said property; thence north 181.4 feet to a point 4 feet south of the north line of said property; thence east 4 feet to the east line of said property."

"Along the northerly side and approximately 4 ft. southerly from the northerly line of the following described premises:

Beginning at a point 95.7 feet south 0 degrees 59' west from the southwest corner of lot 6 in block 2 of Holeman's Addition to Eugene, as platted and recorded at page 14 of vol. 6 Lane County, Oregon, Plat Records, the said beginning point being 290 feet south 89 degrees 44' east from a point 951.2 feet south 0 degrees 59' west from the northwest corner of the east half of the Prior F. Blair Donation Land Claim No. 39, in township 17 South Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian, and running thence South 89 degrees 44' east 520.7 feet to the middle of the county road, thence along the middle of the county road south 10 degrees 20' west 104.38 feet, thence north 89 degrees 44' west 539.8 feet, thence north 0 degrees 59' east 102.69 feet, to the place of beginning, containing 1.25 acres in Lane County Oregon."

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
