## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That Joseph A. & MARIE C. DIEDRICH

of Route 2, Box 146, Salem , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Willamette River a tributary of Columbia River

for the purpose of

Irrigation under Permit No. 14446 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 22. 1940

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $NN_4^2$   $SN_4^2$  as projected on D.L.C. No. 37, Section 3, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.9 acre in the NW2 NW4 an projected on J. B. Keizer D.L.C. No. 37, 7.8 acres in the SW4 NW4 as projected on J. B. Keizer D.L.C. No. 37, Section 3,

T. 7 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point 79.01 chains North 89° 30' West and 50 links South from the Northeast corner of the Donation Land Claim of J. B. Keizer and wife, in Township 7 South, Range 3 West of Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, Oregon; thence North 89° 30' West 5.00 chains parallel to the North line of J. B. Keizer's Claim; thence South 27.33 chains to the North bank of the Willamette River; thence North 85° 30' East 18 links; thence South 88° East 4.83 chains; thence North 27.45 chains to the place of beginning; being situated in the Donation Land Claim of J. B. Keizer and wife, in Township 7 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, State of Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
