CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ADA LOUBARD WOOD

of Glide , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Horth Umpque River a tributary of Umpque River for the purpose of Domestic, including the irrigation of a lawn not exceeding acre in area.

under Permit No. 14307 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 21, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW2 SE4, Section 9, Township 26 South, Range 3 West, N. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NK2 SEA, Section 9, T. 26 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

All that part of the north half of the southeast querter and the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter, (SWISE) of Section nine (9) Township twenty-six (26) South of Range three (3) West of the Willamstte Meridian lying on the westerly side of the North Unoqua River subject to the exception made in the petent from the United States of America to said Harry C Wood conveying said land, covering that part of said premises lying on the river side of a boundary line located one hundred (100) feet from ordinary high-water lines of said river; also excepting: Beginning at the center quarter corner of Section nine (9) in Township twenty-six (26) South Range three (3) West of the Willamette Heridian; thence south eighty-nine degrees (89°) seventern minutes (17') east thirteen and two hundred and forty one-thousandths (13.240) chains to the north right of way fence of the County Road; thence following said right of way fence couth forty Degrees (40°) seven minutes (7') West eight hundred and sixty-four one-thousandths (.864) chains, south thirty-six degrees (36°) forty two sinutes (42') West three and four hundred and thirty-one one-thousandths (3.431) chains, South thirty-seven degrees (37°) fifty-four minutes (54') West one and nine hundred and two one-thousandths (1.902) chains, South twenty-eight degrees (28°) thirth-six minutes (36') West three and two hundred and thirty one-thousands (3.230)

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chains, and South twenty-three degrees (23°) fifty-eight minutes (58°) West nine and two hundred and thirty-two one-thousandths (3.232) chains to a cross-fence; thence following said cross-fence north forty-five degrees (45°) fifty-one minutes (51°) West three and one hundred and twenty-five one-thousandths (3.125) chains, north fifty-five degrees (55°) twenty-nine minutes (29°) west one and ninety-seven one-thousandths (1.097) chains, north four degrees (4°) two minutes (2°) East two and seven hundred and forty-seven one-thousandth (2.747) chains, North two degrees (2°) twenty nine minutes, (29°) Mest three and eight one-thousandths (3.008) chains, and North forty-seven degrees (4°) thirty-seven (37°) West one and two hundred and forty-four one-thousandths (1.244) chains; thence north no degrees (0°) fifty-five minutes (55°) East six and nine-hundred and seventeen one-thousandths (6.917) chains to the place of beginning, containing eleven and sixty-four hundredths (11.64) acress more or less, in the northwest corner of the southeast quarter of Section nine (9) of aforesaid Township and Range and also including herein and agreeing to convey as part of the promises covered by this contract, all rights and easements granted to said Harry C. Wood by deed from Golia Debendardi and Hilds Debendardi, his wife by deed dated May 25, 1931 and recorded in volume 93 at page 347 thereof records of Deeds of Douglas County, Oregon, which deed granted to the said Harry C Wood the right and easement forever to use the water from a spring located on said last described ract, which contains eleven and sixty-four hundredths acres, more or less, subject to all the terms and conditions of said easement, the same being more particularly set out in said deed record to which reference is bereby made.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
